Good afternoon,

As you are aware, Grayson Bottom is out of the office and will not be able to attend the City Council Meeting on May 22, 2013.

We scheduled this meeting on Wednesday, May 22, 2013, due to RECON – ICSC’s Annual Conference. Three of our City Council Members are attending the convention.

After the roll call, we will hold the Public Hearing to receive the public’s input regarding the 2013-14 budget. The City Council will meet with the Department Directors on May 28th and 29th to discuss the budget further.

In the YMA Consent Docket, we are requesting that you approve Series B of the Revenue Bond. This phase will include the repair of 9th Street (Poplar to Oak), 9th Street (Oak to Maple), 5th Street (Main to Ash), Vandament (West end to Frisco Road), and Inla (11th to 5th Street). This item is also included in the Consent Docket.

Another item in the Consent Docket is the City’s guarantee on the Yukon BMX loan. The funds for this loan were borrowed from YNB to construct the concession stand. The BMX Parents & Riders Association have not missed a payment. The balance of the loan is \$4,840.47.

Item No. 3 pertains to the Jackie Cooper Air Conditioning project. The lowest bidder’s cost is \$141,900.00. There were five contractors that submitted bids. The highest bid was \$170,110.00. Should you approve, this project will have a positive impact on the success of this facility. For years, we have received requests that the building needed air conditioning.
