Subject: City Council Update

We should have an informative meeting next Tuesday. Our City Council Consent Agenda contains our annual agreements for services with Youth and Family Services, Inc., Chisholm Trail Historical Preservation Society, and Yukon Sharing. Also, our annual agreement with Derrel S. White CPAs for our annual audit will be considered. All of the associated amounts have been previously approved in our budget.

Our first action item is to consider the recommendation of the Planning Commission concerning the preliminary plat of 283 lots in Frisco Ridge. Robbie Williams and Phil Hagen with Crafton Tull Engineers will be present at both the study session and City Council meeting to make presentations and answer questions. This project was submitted to our Community Development Department that prepared the necessary documentation for consideration by the Planning Commission and included a do pass recommendation. The Planning Commission voted to not approve the preliminary plat and has sent it to Council with that recommendation. You are being asked to consider approving the Planning Commission's recommendation to deny the preliminary plat.

The second action item is to consider approving the enabling legislation to establish the Yukon Economic Development Authority and accept the initial roster of Trustees. Unlike the YMA, the Trustees of YEDA is a blend between City Council representatives and private sector citizens. The initial roster includes Ken Smith, John Alberts, Mike Geers, Donna Yanda, Rena Holland, Ray Wright, and John Nail. Please take a moment to read or review the document. While the legislation grants broad powers to the Authority, the City Council retains final approval of project agreements and all large expenditures of funds associated with those agreements.

I am very pleased to present to you for your consideration the renewal of our Collective Bargaining Agreement with the International Association of Firefighters Local #2055. The two major changes from last year's agreement and this agreement is 1) this is a three year contract and 2) the firefighters chose to not accept a raise for this year in order to get a Training Officer. The training officer position will be a 40 hour per week job rather than the normal shift work utilized by regular firefighters.

The fourth and final action item is to consider for approval of the final plat for a piece of property located at 12701 NW 10th Street (east of the theater) to be utilized as the site of Gold's Gym. This plat is being recommended to you by the Planning Commission.
