



Yukon Police Department Officer Applicant Information Sheet

The City of Yukon, Police Department, is conducting the following recruitment process in order to hire (3) three Police Officers and create an eligibility list for future openings.

Position Description

An officer performs the regular duties of a law enforcement officer during one of the three assigned 8 hour shifts. Applicants must be able to be state certified as law enforcement officers. Career advancement is available and may include such special assignments as investigations, school resource officer, bike team, firearms instructor, tactical team, and others. The Yukon Police Department is a full-service agency.

Requirements

Police Officer must be a U. S. citizen, 21 years of age at the date of appointment, possess valid driver's license, and have a minimum of 60 hours college credits. Educational hours may be waived with either two years of full-time police experience or related military experience with an honorable discharge. Applicant must provide proof of college credit hours with application. Applicants must not have any felony or domestic abuse convictions or have any visible tattoos.

Salary and Benefits

The City of Yukon offers the full range of benefits which is one of the best in the State of Oklahoma. The starting salary for Police Officer is \$35,185. The City of Yukon offers health insurance as well as educational incentive pay, paid holiday and vacation days.

Recruitment Process

The hiring process of Police Officer along with creating an eligibility list with the City of Yukon is as follows;

1) Applications may be obtained, completed and returned to the Personnel Department of Yukon at the City Hall, 500 W. Main St. (Hwy. 66) Yukon, OK by **May 18th, 2012**. City Hall is open Monday through Friday from 8:30 a.m. until **5:00 p.m.**

If application materials are not received by this date or these materials are not properly completed, this will result in your inability to proceed further in the process,

2) The physical agility and written testing will be held on Friday, **May 25th, 2012**.

-Physical Agility tests will be held at the Yukon Middle School Stadium located at 1000 W. Yukon Avenue starting at **8:30 a.m.**

-Written test will be conducted at the Yukon Police Department located at 100 S. Ranchwood and will begin at **2:00 p.m.**

3) An oral interview will be conducted of all applicants that have successfully passed the written and physical agility test. An Oral Review Board will consist of a panel of department and City officials.

4) Those applicants successfully completing the oral interview will be placed on an eligibility test that will be active for one year. The Chief of Police will select applicants from that list when openings occur.

5) An applicant selected to fill a vacancy in the department will undergo an extensive background investigation by a supervisor of the Yukon Police Department.

6) After successfully completing the background investigation, a conditional job offer will be made to the applicant. The conditional job offer is pending the successful completion of a psychological test and state police pension medical exam.

7) Having successfully completed all phases of this testing process, the applicant will be given a start date as a probationary officer based upon either current certification as a commissioned officer or start date of the CLEET Basic Academy.

Other information regarding testing process;

- All tests are pass/fail with a minimum passing score of 75 %.
- The applicant must pass each stage of the physical agility test.
