Qualifications

- **Minimum of 60 accredited college hours or 2 years full time sworn law enforcement experience or 2 years active duty military service with honorable discharge.**
- **Between the ages of 21 and 45**
- **Valid state driver's license**
- **No history involving moral turpitude**
- **No felony or domestic violence convictions**
- **Must pass physical agility test and Obstacle Course (CLEET)**
- **Must all pass written and oral interview exams**
- **Must pass Psychological examination (MMPI)**
- **Must pass extensive background investigation**
- **Must pass Police Pension Board Physical and drug screening**
- **Any visible tattoo(s), intentional scarring, and/or brand(s) exposed on the applicant's body when wearing a short sleeve patrol uniform is a disqualifier for the police officer hiring process.**



Police Academy

All Non-Certified Officers will attend a 14 week basic police academy in Ada, Oklahoma certified by the Council on Law Enforcement Education and Training (CLEET).

Field Training

Probationary Certified Officers will complete approximately 14 weeks in field training (FTO). Instruction will be taught by an FTO officer with rotation occurring through all patrol shifts in order to expose the probationary officer to all facets of patrol.

Solo Assignment

Upon successful completion of FTO, probationary officers are assigned to a patrol shift where they begin their solo duties patrolling and responding for calls for service in the City of Yukon.

Specialties

After probation, officers can look forward to a rewarding career and opportunities exist to join specialized units. (Bicycle Team, Criminal Investigations, Crisis Intervention Team, Drug Recognition Expert, Field Training Officer, Honor Guard, Instructor, School Resource Officer, and Tactical Team)
