

NOTICE OF INTENT TO REQUEST RELEASE OF FUNDSApril 30, 2014City of Yukon, OklahomaP. O. Box 850500Yukon, Oklahoma 73085(405) 627-0456

On or about May 12, 2014 the City of Yukon Oklahoma will authorize the Mayor to submit a request to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce (ODOC) for the release of Community Development Block Grant funds under Title 1 of the Housing and Community Development Act of 1974, as amended, to undertake a project known as CDBG SC 2012 Yukon CI-03404 for the purpose of replacement of infrastructure, water, sewer and associated paving between Main Street and Ash, Garth Brooks Blvd. and Cornwell Rd.

The activities proposed comprise a project for which a finding of no significant impact on the environment was posted on April 30, 2014. An Environmental Review Record (ERR) that documents the environmental determinations for this project is on file at City of Yukon, 500 West Main Street, Yukon, OK, 73085, and may be examined or copied weekdays 8 A.M. to 5 P.M.

PUBLIC COMMENTS

Any individual, group, or agency may submit written comments on the ERR to the Mayor. All comments received by May 12, 2014, will be considered by the Mayor prior to authorizing submission of a request for release of funds.

RELEASE OF FUNDS

The City of Yukon certifies to ODOC that Ken Smith in his capacity as Mayor consents to accept the jurisdiction of the Federal Courts if an action is brought to enforce responsibilities in relation to the environmental review process and that these responsibilities have been satisfied. ODOC approval of the certification satisfies its responsibilities under NEPA and related laws and authorities, and allows the City of Yukon to use Program funds.

OBJECTIONS TO RELEASE OF FUNDS

ODOC will consider objections to its release of funds and the City of Yukon certification received by May 27, 2014, or for a period of fifteen days following its actual receipt of the request (whichever is later) only if they are on one of the following bases: (a) the certification was not executed by the Certifying Officer of the City of Yukon; (b) the City of Yukon has omitted a step or failed to make a decision or finding required by HUD regulations at 24 CFR Part 58; (c) the grant recipient or other participants in the project have committed funds or incurred costs not authorized by 24 CFR Part 58 before approval of a release of funds by ODOC; or (d) another Federal agency acting pursuant to 40 CFR Part 1504 has submitted a written finding that the project is unsatisfactory from the standpoint of environmental quality. Objections must be prepared and submitted in accordance with the required procedures (24 CFR Part 58) and shall be addressed to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce, 900 N. Stiles, Oklahoma City, OK 73104. Potential objectors should contact ODOC to verify the actual last day of the objection period.
