A.J. Clements asked when signs would be placed in Wagner Lake Addition. Eric Tucker stated the black poles are needed to be

added and then will proceed from there. Mr. Clements asked, if faded signs are going to be replaced, particularly the one on Highway 66. Eric stated yes.

James Montgomery asked if rumble strips were a definite in Stone Mill addition. Doug Shivers stated recommendation is made to City Manager and the Engineer is looking into them. Mr. Clements stated he was not here for discussion of strips, but is aware it was a hard decision and solution. James Montgomery asked about speed humps and why they were a problem for emergency vehicles. Mr. Clements and Mr. Lee both stated it is when they are between a speed hump and a speed bump, it causes a problem. Mr. Montgomery stated, if speed humps not a problem, we may want to revisit for Stone Mill Addition. Discussion was had about the data presented before.

Jay Tallant was concerned about a stop sign being loose at Kingston and south side of Vandament. Eric Tucker stated it could be loose set screws and would look at it. Mr. Tallant stated pot holes on Holly near Shedeck were getting bigger.

A.J. Clements thanked the Street department for the patching on Garth Brooks. Traffic Commissioners are pleased with new patching machine.

John Knuppel had no concerns, only thanks for the Czech Festival and 5<sup>th</sup> street railroad crossing being fixed.

Eric Tucker stated 5<sup>th</sup> St. and Main had peak video reinstalled. The Garth Brooks issues with traffic will not be able to be fixed, until I-40 construction done. Vandament and Garth Brook had gas leak fixed and road fixed. Wagner Lake and Ranchwood signs have been ordered. New street projects to begin soon.
