Mr. Lee stated the North and South light at Yukon Parkway and Main Street is sticking.

Mr. Lee asked why the entire mile of 10th between Garth Brooks Blvd. and Cornwell was made 40 mph? He had requested the first ½ mile going west from Cornwell drive right over the bridge to be 40 mph. The rest of the ½ mile west to Garth Brooks Blvd. to be 45 mph.

Discussion was held on the traffic on 10th by the new development on the south side of the road.

CONSIDERATION AND POSSIBLE ACTION REGARDING "NO OUTLET" SIGNAGE ON KINGSGATE ROAD IN THE WESTPORT 66 ADDITION.
