ITEM 1: **DISCUSS AND APPROVE THE MINUTES OF THE NOVEMBER 13, 2008 TRAFFIC COMMISSION MEETING.**

ITEM 3: **DISCUSS SURVEYS FOR PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS ON VICTORIA DR.**

Mr. Shivers presented survey results for stop sign placement at Victoria Dr. and John F. Kroutil. The results were not opposed to 2-way stop sign on Victoria Dr.

Captain Knight the speed trailer posted at the location in December and found the average speed was 19 mph.

Mr. Shivers stated that the stop sign placement had previously been approved by council and not opposed.

ITEM 4: **DISCUSS SURVEYS FOR PLACEMENT OF STOP SIGNS AT KINGSRIDGE AND CANTEBERRY.**

Mr. Shivers presented survey results for 4-way stop sign placement at Kingsridge and Canteberry. The results were not opposed to the 4-way stop signs.

Captain Knight had the speed trailer posted at the location and found the average speed was 20.84 mph.

The commission members studied a previous diagram of Canteberry and Kingsridge. The intersection at the location is off-set. The decision on placement of the 4-way stop signs has been tabled until further studies are complete and not approved.

ITEM 5: **TRAFFIC CONCERNS**

Mr. Wiedenmaier wanted to follow-up from previous traffic meeting with the commission. There is traffic congestion causing a blind intersection on Victoria Dr. at Holly. He suggested that “no parking” signs be placed on the west side of Holly and north of Victoria Dr.

Motion for “no parking” signs to be placed on Holly at Victoria Dr.
