Mr. Lee says at the Main and Parkway street light, the south bound straight thru is locked on. He also noticed the no parking and standing signs have been installed at Ridgeway.

Ms. Parker has nothing at this time.

Mr. Tallant wanted to say thanks for the Ridgeway sign installation.

Mr. Shivers received an email from Justin Christy, he is with the Home Owners Association in Frisco Ridge. The edition wants speed limit signs and no parking signs. Mr. Shivers asked the commission to study locations for consideration at next meeting.

Mr. Tucker turned in order for street signs from Parkway to Frisco. He is also finishing signs and black poles on Holly, working on stripping, replacing sidewalks and finishing traffic study on Garth Brooks and Main.
