ITEM 3: **DISCUSS TRAFFIC CONCERNS**

Mr. Knuppel presented a traffic concern by a citizen. The concern is about the northbound lanes on Ranchwood Blvd. at Main St. After recent construction the location has become 2 lanes. The citizen is concerned about the right lane turning left also, instead of proceeding straight ahead.

Mr. Shivers mentioned the addition of an arrow sign by street light.

Sgt. Brown mentioned to also change light to an arrow up light.

Mr. Lee said an arrow sign would be cheaper.

Mr. Shivers will contact Public Works for the cost and installation of arrow signs on northbound Ranchwood Blvd. at Main St.

Mr. Shivers presented an email received from Captain Merry. Citizens have requested a 3-way stop sign to be installed at E. Olympic and Big Horn Canyon. Their complaint was speeding.

Mr. Lee surveyed the location and said a stop sign could be placed at cul-de-sac; north of dead end section.

Mr. Shivers will contact Public Works Dept. on how to correct the concrete median on Ranchwood Blvd. and Vandament.
