Mr. Tallant asked what the standards are for left turn on green light. There was a wreck at the intersection of Main St. and Cornwell in January and it is a dangerous intersection.

Mr. Albrecht has noticed the road on 11th St. and Inla St. needs repair in the railroad crossing area. He also mentioned the timing of the east stoplights in front of IES School is incorrect.

Miss. Parker mentioned the timing of the stoplights at 10th St. and Yukon Parkway is incorrect also.

Mr. Lee asked to have the timing of stoplights checked at 5th St. and Main St.

Mr. Stover will turn the above information into Public Works Dpt.

Captain Johnson inquired about the installment of the turn and straight arrow signs at Ranchwood and Main St.

Mr. Stover gave an update report to the Commissioners.

- Sunken pavement at Twilight and Eastview has been repaired.
- Yield signs replaced with Stop signs at Ronald and Von Elm; on Redwood at 8th and 9th St; on Sycamore between 8th and 9th St. Purchase Order turned in for new poles and street signs for locations.
- 35 mph Speed limit signs with poles have been purchased for placement along Vandament from Ranchwood Blvd. going east to the corporate limits. Installation by Friday, March 16th.
- Purchase Order turned in to purchase new Speed limit signs and poles on Landmark; move sign locations on Landmark.
- Purchase Order turned in for new turn and straight arrow signs for Ranchwood and Main St. location.
