ITEM 3: **DISCUSS FRISCO RIDGE SUBDIVISION TRAFFIC**

Justin Christy, Home Owner's Association Representative, and E.R. Sadler, member of HOA Board, talked about the concerns in the Frisco Ridge Subdivision.

Mr. Christy and E.R. Sadler are concerned about the traffic in their subdivision as follows: the general traffic in the subdivision, no speed limit signs and limited stop signs, parking on the streets near the entry and it creating a visibility hazard, and visibility issues due to plants on the median on Highway 66.

The Traffic Commission discussed the concerns and issues of the Frisco Ridge Subdivision Traffic and were able to contribute recommendations as follows:

1. Remove 5 Crepe Myrtles from the West side of entry on Highway 66 Median.

2. Post Speed Limit 25 sign on inbound Frisco Ridge Rd. at 100' before curb cutout.

3. Post Speed Limit 25 on eastbound Branch Line Rd. from Frisco Ridge at 100'.

4. Post 2-Way Stop on Swingman and Branch line. At a later date, may look into doing a traffic count.

5. Frisco Ridge- No Parking 30' to Stop sign at Highway 66, then allow parking 80' back, and no more parking available on Frisco Ridge.

ITEM 4:

DISCUSS TRAFFIC CONCERNS

Mr. Tallant wanted to know, if Captain Johnson had done study on Woodlawn. Mr. Shivers said Captain Johnson was arranging police enforcement for the area, as well as getting a speed trailer.

Mr. Tallant decided to observe traffic at Shedeck, due to the concerns of cars speeding and cutting through neighborhoods.

Mr. Tallant said he watched approximately 28 cars and believed there was no problem with the traffic.

Mr. Tallant questioned the lights being fixed on Main street. Mr. Tucker stated they have cleaned them, but may try the haze removal that you use on car headlights.

Mr. Tallant requested a new city map. City Hall has new maps and will provide one to Mr. Tallant.

Mr. Lee has nothing at this time.

Mr. Knuppel talked about traffic lights on main street. He says the sun is affecting visibility.

Mr. Knuppel talked about the Sheddeck traffic. He said a citizen on Montreal stated most of the traffic violators are young people.

Mr. Tucker gave an updated report on the Star program.

- 72 LED crosswalks
- NW 10th & Vandament has new traffic signs
- Lake View Elementary has two new signs.

He also discussed the processor at 4th & Main was out and is in for repairs and the camera is broken. NW 10th processor was out and is now repaired. Stripping will start next week.
