

DISPOSE OF LAWN CLIPPINGS AND TREE LIMBS FOR FREE

Now through April 14

Place an unlimited number of garbage bags filled with yard lawn and leaf waste at the curb by 6 a.m. on your neighborhood's routine garbage pickup day, and the City of Yukon Sanitation Services Dept. will pick them up for free. Bags should weigh no more than 50 pounds and be durable. Tree limbs will also be picked up for free, if cut into 4 feet maximum lengths and bundled together with twine or rope. Bundles should not exceed 50 pounds. Place bags and bundles at the curb at least three feet away from your trash cart, so that the automated sanitation truck can empty it that day. A separate crew and truck will come through your neighborhood to pick up bags and limbs. Help become part of the solution rather than part of the problem!

Spring is in the air! It is the time of year to be working in your yard. Blowing or leaving grass clippings and other debris in the street during yard maintenance doesn't just look bad it is illegal. **Do not blow them to the street.**

This is the time of year for getting your pools ready for the season too. Pool owners are preparing to drain and clean their pools are reminded that it is illegal to discharge chlorinated pool water down their neighborhood storm drains. If your pool is not connected to a sanitary sewer line for draining, the water must be de-chlorinated before releasing on site and be approved by the City.

Another violation is dumping pool chemicals in your dumpsters for sanitation to haul off in trash trucks. This is highly dangerous for city employees when the trucks catch on fire and put off fumes when these chemicals mix with other trash.

This is a violation of our City Ordinance. Do your part to keep the drainage system clean.
