Important Billing Information for CITY OF YUKON UTILITY CUSTOMERS

Rate increases recently approved by the Yukon City Council are effective with the first bill after 10-1-12. Each new ordinance has an automatic annual Consumer Price Index (CPI) increase that occurs every October unless the City Council votes not to implement it for that particular year. Yukon ranks mid-range among area municipalities, even with the following rate increases:

Garbage – Ordinance No. 1278 allows for an increase of \$1.00 per month for residential customers and increases commercial rates as well.

Sewer – Ordinance No. 1279 increases sanitary sewer rates by 20% now and each year for the next four years, after which time the automatic CPI increase will go into effect. The City of Yukon's cost to treat wastewater is currently \$3.65 per 1,000 gallons. Billed charges to customers prior to this increase were \$1.66 per 1,000 gallons. Now, customer charges will be based on the city's actual cost of treating wastewater.

Water – Ordinance No. 1280 does not include an increase in water rates this year.

CITY OF YUKON WATER, SEWER & GARBAGE MONTHLY RATES

Effective first bill after October 1, 2012

WATER

0 to 2,000 gallons	\$11.01
2,000 to 12,000 gallons	\$3.65 per each 1,000 gallons
12,000 + over	\$4.30 per each 1,000 gallons

SEWER

0 to 4,000 gallons	\$5.32
4,000 gallons + over	\$2.48 per each 1,000 gallons metered water usage during Summer months (April, May, June, July, August and September)
4,000 gallons + over	\$4.37 per each 1,000 gallons metered water usage during Winter months (October, November, December, January, February and March)

RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE

Customers may be issued up to two polycarts at the following monthly rates.

0 to 3,000 gallons water	\$4.96
3,000 gallons + over	\$17.08

RURAL RESIDENTIAL GARBAGE

Customers may be issued to up two polycarts at the following monthly rates and are charged for each additional cart thereafter.
