


Frisco Road Economic Development Project Plan

NOTICE OF PUBLIC HEARING

THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF YUKON WILL HOLD A PUBLIC HEARING ON THE PROPOSED FRISCO ROAD ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROJECT PLAN ON MARCH 4, 2014, AT 7:00 PM IN THE COUNCIL CHAMBERS AT THE CENTENNIAL BUILDING, 12 SOUTH 5TH STREET, YUKON, OKLAHOMA. THIS SECOND HEARING WILL PROVIDE MEMBERS OF THE PUBLIC AN OPPORTUNITY TO BE HEARD PRIOR TO ANY COUNCIL VOTE ON THE PROPOSED FRISCO ROAD ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT PROJECT PLAN, INCLUDING SALES, USE, AND HOTEL OCCUPANCY TAX INCREMENT DISTRICT NUMBER 1, CITY OF YUKON.



The primary purposes of the Project Plan are to provide the economic structure and funding needed to support the construction of a four ramp interchange at Frisco Road and I-40, as well as the creation of an attractive viable commercial corridor south of I-40 and east of Frisco Road that will be anchored by a hotel and other retail establishments. The proposed commercial corridor along I-40 will expand employment opportunities in the surrounding area, enhance the tax base, and provide quality of life amenities to the residents of the City of Yukon and the surrounding area.

The principal objectives of the Project Plan are:

- A. The construction the Frisco Road/I-40 interchange, which will serve as a catalyst to attract major investment in the area and to expand employment.
- B. To enhance the tax base and make possible investment, development, and economic growth that would otherwise be difficult without the Project and the apportionment of incremental sales tax revenues.
- C. To stimulate private commitments to invest in the Project Area.
- D. To create an attractive viable commercial center, including retail and hotel uses, to attract residents and visitors.

The Mabel C. Fry Public Library is proud to offer an array of excellent programs for children, teens and adults.


