

Community Design Survey for the Frisco Road Retail Development

The City of Yukon, through the Yukon City Council and the Yukon Economic Development Authority (Trust), is excited to be making progress on the Frisco Road Economic Development Project Plan. The project will include a four ramp east-west interchange at Frisco Road and I-40 as well as an attractive, viable, commercial corridor south of I-40 and east of Frisco Road. This project will put Yukon on the map of large retail developments within the Oklahoma City metro area with the opportunity to create a 200 acre regional destination center that includes; retail shopping, entertainment and restaurants, community spaces, mixed-use commercial business, hotel/conference center, and public amenities.



A major objective of the Frisco Road Project Plan is to support and improve the quality of life for residents of Yukon and Canadian County. For this important reason, the City is conducting this design study/survey as a first step in the extensive process of drafting a project master plan that will be used to help guide the public and private development of the TIF District. As a citizen of the community, we encourage you to participate in this planning exercise by answering a few general questions about the overall type of development you wish to see on Frisco Road.
