

• Oklahoma was admitted to the union on Nov. 16, 1907. Guthrie served as the state capital until 1910, when the capital was moved to Oklahoma City.


• The capitol building at 23rd and Lincoln is the only capitol in the nation with a working oil well on its grounds.




OKC MSA Employment by Industry




Oklahoma City skyline
