## Minutes of November 3, 1959

The Yukon City Council met in regular session in the office of the City Clerk at 8:00 A.M. November 3, 1959.

PRESENT: Councilmen Frank, Greene, Seikel, Turner and Mayor Belisle.

ABSENT: None.

Also present were City Manager David Morgan, L.M. Bush, Robert Kouba, Glen McKinney, E. Streeter, Orville Taylor, S.G. Johnson, and Dean Wallen.

A Resolution was offered by Councilman Seikel to open each regular Council meeting with prayer by a guest minister. Councilman Greene to contact minister for the next meeting. The motion was seconded by Councilman Turner. Roll was called with the following result:

AYES: Councilmen Frank, Greene, Seikel, Turner and Mayor Belisle.

NAYES: None.

Reverend Greene opened the meeting with prayer.

Minutes of October 6, 13, and 21 were read and approved upon a motion made by Councilman Seikel and seconded by Councilman Frank. Roll was called with the following result:

AYES: Councilmen Frank, Greene, Seikel, Turner and Mayor Belisle.

NAYES: None.

Discussion of alley running north and south, north of Cedar between 10th and 11th streets. No action taken; tabled for future settlement.

Plat filed by Carmichael for George Addition.

Closing alley protest by residents represented by Streeter.

Orville Taylor presented preliminary plat for Hillcrest Heights Addition and was accepted by Council upon a motion made by Councilman Turner and seconded by Councilman Frank. Roll was called with the following result:

AYES: Councilmen Frank, Greene, Seikel, Turner and Mayor Belisle.

NAYES: None.

Mr. Bush suggested a special meeting for December 8, 1959. He also set the date of December 29, 1959, at 7:30 P.M. to take bids for Water Improvement Project.

Mr. Bush advised that \$50,000 be deposited to take care of immediate bills as Chamber of Commerce, Cochran Milburn Fee, Bush Engineer Preliminary Fee, Right of Way, and Miscellaneous Expense and the balance of \$300,000 be deposited in 91 day U.S. Treasury Bills.

A motion was made by Councilman Greene and seconded by Councilman Frank to enforce the Hog Ordinance in improved sections of the City upon Citizen's complaints. Roll was called with the following result:
