Minutes of December 1, 1959

The City Council of the City of Yukon, Canadian County, State of Oklahoma, met in regular session in the Council Room of the City Hall of said City of Yukon, Oklahoma, on the 1st day of December, 1959, at 8:00 A.M.

PRESENT:

The invocation was given by Reverend Harold Leveridge, Pastor of the Yukon Methodist Church.

The first order of business was the reading of the minutes of the regular meeting of November Z, 1959; there upon a motion was made by Councilman Seikel, seconded by Councilman Frank, that the minutes be approved as read. Roll was called with the following result:

The developer has requested approval of a sanitary sewer line extension to serve a part of Hillcrest Heights addition. The Water Bond engineer has requested authority to drill several test holes for quantity and quality of water in a general area north of the City. The report on acquisition of right-of-way and land for water-works improvement was discussed and tabled until the next meeting.

Discussion of the request of property owners in Block 12 for an alley running north and south through that block followed. The Council unanimously agreed to take no action.

A motion was made by Councilman Frank, seconded by Councilman Greene, that the City Manager and Councilman Turner draw up insurance specifications for presentation to insurance companies, and request bids for same.
