Minutes of December 18, 1959

The City Council of the .City Of Yukon met at 8:00 A.M 'December 18, 1959, in the City Hall in an adjourned meeting from Court Room.

PRESENT: Councilmen Frank, Greene, Seikel, Turner and Mayor Belisle.

ABSENT: None.

The purpose of this meeting was to decide upon course of action to be taken regarding the acquisition of Electric Distribution System.

There was discussion on the subject. "If Yukon Electric obtains permanent injunction, and City appealed to Supreme Court", attorney and court costs would not exceed \$1000.00 and outside financial help would be provided. It was suggested that City Manager contact qualified Municipal attorneys as to legal status of City interfering with Yukon Electric and O G & E negotiations. Also to consult with engineer and bondsman, and representative from some electrical distribution company on the advisability of establishing a competitive system. The advisability of obtaining additional counsel was discussed. No definite action was taken on this.

There was a suggestion that protest be made to Federal Power Commission, but' no action was taken on this.

Mayor Belisle then stated he felt there should be no backing down on effort to acquire Electric Distribution System and asked for motion to give notice to attorney to safeguard the City's interest by right of appeal if final court decision is adverse to City. Thereupon the motion was made by Councilman Seikel and seconded by Councilman Turner with roll call as follows:

The meeting was then adjourned subject to call by Mayor upon affirmative vote of all members.
