

RULES AND REGULATIONS

1. The rules and interpretations of those rules are at the discretion of the event organizers. If you desire clarification on any stated or unstated rules, it is your responsibility to seek that clarification.
2. A cooking team shall consist of a head cook and no more than three assistants. In an attempt to keep the cooking area safe and sightly, only members of the cooking team should be present in the cooking area. Set-up time begins at 3:00 PM on the 3rd and ends at 7:00AM on the 4th. Moving vehicles are only allowed in that period.
3. Teams may enter any and all categories, the Grand Champion will be based on a combined score of all meat categories.
4. Categories include: Chicken, Beef Brisket, and Pork
5. A cook area is defined as a 15'x15' space.
6. No tobacco, alcohol, or animals allowed in the cooking area.
7. Team must provide all required equipment: smoker, cooking supplies, tables, chairs, tents, etc.
8. Event organizers will supply a turn-in box for each category entered and a trash cart for trash disposal.
9. All meat must be cooked on site during competition times, no pre-cooked meats are allowed.
10. The sale of items is prohibited.
11. Sauce is optional but must be applied directly to the meats.

SCORING REGULATIONS

1. Each category will be judged individually and awarded a winner, and a Grand Champion will be named for combined score.
2. All entries must be submitted to the turn-in table within five minutes of the turn-in time for each category. No late entries will be judged. Turn-in times are as follows:

Chicken:	1:30
Beef Brisket:	2:00
Pork:	2:30

3. Awards include up to \$500 in cash plus trophies. The awards presentation will begin at 4:00 or when scores are finalized.

4. The scoring system is done for each meat category by each judge,. The scale is 9-2 with 9 being excellent, 8 very good, 7 above average, 6 average, 5 below average, 4 poor, 3 bad, and 2 inedible. A score of 1 is used only in the case of a disqualification as result of not following the rules and regulations or failing to submit an entry.
5. Entries will be judged using this scale on their taste, tenderness, and appearance. The following weighting factors are applied to the scores: Taste - 2.2972, Tenderness - 1.1428, and Appearance - .5600
6. Your scores will then be added together, the highest cumulative total will win that category.
7. There will be five judges so please be sure to submit five samples in your turn-in box.
